



# SG21 Subcategory Update – Fall 2023 Section and Student Coding

*Extract Data as of February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023*

## Context

This data extract update provides section and student-level coding from Summer 2021 until the present and allows each college to see SG21 efforts since the region implemented SG21 subcategory coding. It allows institutions to see the volume of students that had an SG21 experience over time, what type of SG21 subcategory experiences are being coded through enrollments and expected SG21 counts in MIS.

The counts are unduplicated to represent sections and/or students with at least one SG21 subcategory experience. Fall 2023 data includes section-level subcategories being coded at each institution. The percent of students that had at least one SG21 experience out of the student population that term as well as demographic information (age, ethnicity, gender) compared to student demographics from the Office of Institutional Effectiveness and Research's [Student Profiles dashboard](#) is also included. Internal MIS data expectations and MIS data available from [CCCCO's Datamart](#) are also provided.

### 2. What percent of students had at least one SG21 experience in Fall 2023?

Out of **City College's** 13,153 students, 1,124 (**8.5%**) had an **SG21** experience.

Out of **Mesa College's** 19,279 students, 5,617 (**29.1%**) had an **SG21** experience.

Out of **Miramar College's** 12,675 students, 323 (**2.5%**) had an **SG21** experience.

Out of the **College of Continuing Education's** 14,868 students, 962 (**6.5%**) had an **SG21** experience.

**Districtwide**, of the 53,767 students enrolled in Fall 2023, 7,692 (**14.3%**) had at least one **SG21** experience. \*

## 6. Which Subcategories were coded at the section level for Fall 2023?

Below are highlights for each college from Fall 2023 section coding. Please look at the appendix for section and enrollment counts by SG21 subcategory from Spring 2019 to Spring 2024 for each college.

**City College:** The most coded subcategory for sections and enrollment was Career Readiness (C5). For Fall 2023, twenty sub-categories were coded, missing Internships which are A5 (unpaid) and A6 (Paid). [Appendix: City College \(Table 9\)](#)

**Mesa College:** The most coded subcategories by sections and enrollment were Career Readiness (C5) and Career Speaker (C3). For Fall 2023, twenty-one subcategories were coded, missing only B7 (Student-run commercial or social enterprises). [Appendix: Mesa College \(Table 10\)](#)

**Miramar College:** The most coded subcategory by sections and enrollment was Career Readiness (C5). There were six subcategories coded in Fall 2023 (A1, A4, A8, C3, C5 and C7). [Appendix: Miramar College \(Table 11\)](#)

**College of Continuing Education:** There were four coded subcategories in Fall 2023, in order of most code by section and enrollment, they were Career Readiness (C5), Mock Interviews (C4), Capstone Projects (A2), and Career Fairs (C1). [Appendix: College of Continuing Education \(Table 12\)](#)

## 7. What are our total MIS counts by SG21 category?

Important facts about [MIS reporting for SG21](#):

- MIS reporting is unduplicated by College. If the student is identified as participating in more than one type of work-based learning during the reporting term, report the first applicable code (A through C). *Examples: If a student participates in a WBL activity within the A, B, and C categories, they are only recorded as A. If a student participates in a WBL activity within the B, and C categories, they are only recorded as B. Table 7 below shows student counts applying MIS hierarchy logic. Only A, B, or C are shown.*
- MIS Code Definitions:
  - **A** - Student participated in work-based learning preparing the student for employment in a specific range of occupations, such as internships, work experience, and capstone projects
  - **B** - Student participated in work-based learning allowing the student to apply learning through practical experience and interaction with professionals from industry and the community outside of school, such as job shadows, service learning, class projects or challenges, and mentorships
  - **C** - Student participated in work-based learning allowing the student to build awareness of the variety of careers available, begin identifying areas of interest, and explore career options, such as guest speakers, company tours, field trips, career fairs, and mock interviews
  - **N** – Student did not participate in Work-Based Learning
  - **X** – Unknown / Unreported
