Equity Gaps in Priority Jobs and Programs: Considerations for Community College Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging Strategies

This collaborative report, made in partnership with San Diego County's local Workforce Development Board, identifies priority jobs and programs and evaluates any equity gaps that exist within them. **Understanding these gaps can inform recruitment and retention efforts.**

Highlights:

- There are 91 priority jobs and 98 priority programs in San Diego
- Underrepresentation in Priority Jobs:
 - Women are significantly underrepresented in 56 priority jobs
 - Males were underrepresented in 33 priority jobs
 - o BIPOC are significantly underrepresented in 72 priority jobs
 - 47 priority jobs have overrepresentation by ages 55+ (retiring workforce)
- Underrepresentation in Priority Programs
 - Youth are underrepresented in 32 priority programs
 - Males are underrepresented in 18 priority programs
 - o Women are underrepresented in 40 priority programs
 - o BIPOC underrepresentation across 44 priority programs
 - Hispanic/Latino have significant underrepresentation in 2 to 29 priority programs
 - Asian have significant underrepresentation in 10 to 19 priority programs
 - Black/African American have significant underrepresentation in 2 to 11 priority programs
 - American Indian/Alaska Native have significant underrepresentation in 1 priority program
 - There are no priority programs with significant underrepresentation for Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islanders

Recommendations

- Community colleges should work with employers to diversify employment in priority jobs and increase underrepresented groups' interest in these positions.
- Community colleges could use this study to identify priority programs with significantly underrepresented groups and develop targeted recruitment and retention strategies accordingly.

Reflective Questions

- How can employers partner with the community colleges to develop and diversify their talent pipeline, particularly in priority jobs with underrepresented groups?
- Has your college worked with industry and local employers to promote hiring of underrepresented groups?
- What successes has your college experienced with targeted marketing campaigns for specific demographic groups (e.g., women, BIPOC, youth)?
- How could you apply those strategies to promote priority programs to underrepresented groups?

What is a Priority Job?

- Requires at least high school diploma but less than a bachelor's degree
- Has 50 annual job openings or more in San Diego County
- Pays at or above the living wage of \$18.43 per hour for a single adult
- Typically requires fewer than 5 years of work experience

What is a Priority Program?

 A Community College program that trains for a priority job
