Connecting Career Education Pathways from SDCCE to college
Accelerating career education degree and certificate completion

- ★ Early College Credit Model
- ★ Connects existing SDCCE courses to college career education courses
- ★ Includes both course alignment and credit by examination
- ★ Two-year renewable agreements
- ★ College faculty-led agreement development

SDCCE to College Course Articulation

Connecting Career Education Pathways from SDCCE to college
Accelerating career education degree and certificate completion

- ★ Benefits Include:
 - Develops collaboration between institutions – establishes and supports clear pathways
 - Accelerates college degree and/or certificate completion
 - Saves students time & money in completing college certificates or degrees
 - Minimizes course duplication
 - Low risk to student (Credit is optional)

Ongoing Overlapping Stages

Agreement Development

- ★ Exchange curriculum
- ★ Deep review of course competencies and evaluation to assess alignment
- ★ Faculty to Faculty discussions
- ★ Agreement on method of final evaluation within the course
- ★ Approved by college faculty

Implementation

- ★ Agreement written to include all components of the partnership.
- ★ Two-year renewal cycle

Awarding College Credit

- ★ Course participation and completion
- ★ Official grades
- ★ Exchange of records
- ★ Validation of IDs and student information
- ★ Processing of credit

Awarding Credit through Course Alignment & Credit by Exam



46 SDCCE courses tied to 36 college courses

Student must earn a “C” or higher in the course

Students must earn a “B” or higher on the approved end of course exam.

Students must apply to the College. Students automatically opt-in to receive college credit at the time of enrollment .

Start of term:



SDCCE Programs with courses tied to CTE Transitions Credit by Exam are encouraged to promote completion of the CCCApply Application in the beginning of the term for the term the student is currently enrolled.

Support for completing the application is available via City, Mesa, and Miramar College Outreach Coordinators.

Programs are encouraged to incorporate this requirement, the full credit by exam process, and college credit opportunity within their Program Orientations, Program webpage/materials, and course syllabi.

STEP 1:

SDCCE provides an orientation to inform students of the CTE Transitions Credit by Exam process and college application requirements.



STEP 2:

SDCCE Student registers for SDCCE CTE Transitions Credit by exam course.

SDCCE courses tied to current CTE Transitions Credit by Exam agreements are identified within the online schedule. Students can hover over the C icon to learn more about the process. Students can search the online schedule for courses that offer credit by exam opportunities.

By enrolling in the course, the student acknowledges that if they meet eligibility requirements they would like to earn college credit by enrolling in this course.



STEP 3:


At time of enrollment, SDCCE STUDENT receives an auto email outlining requirements.

The email is tailored to whether or not they have an active credit college application on file. Students that do not have an active college application at the time of registration will receive additional information in this email to complete their application.

The email includes a link to the Opt-out of College Credit Form. If a student does not want college credit, they must complete the Opt-out of College Credit Form.
