- Debrief and Group Discussion comments made throughout large group review and discussion on reflective activity included:
  - Importance of increasing understanding of each other's words, bureaucracies, and constraints – so that we can all better understanding restrictions and opportunities (its not the person, it the system)
  - Strategies for engaging those who do not reply
  - Recognizing our identities and intersectionality of identities and how we are perceived in the world
