The schedule includes events on Effective Communication, The Art of the Pitch, Building and Maintaining Business Relationships, Market Research & Continuous Learning, Data-Driven Decision Making, and Collaborative Outreach.

- Cross Training planning discussion focused on users and stakeholders. Discussion participants expressed interest in exploring audiences. Discussion included:
 - The importance of reaching out to others beyond direct services roles faculty and staff to increase general awareness
