	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Credit college list of currently course level coded courses • Credit colleges – send us any new courses to code • Roll-over Report <p>Reminders</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Course and Section level coding can occur only when the code is a required or guaranteed activity that all students enrolled in the section will actually do (not just when opportunities are recommended or available as options) • Course level coding can only be done when there is guaranteed consistency across all sections offered (for all terms) • Course level coding occurs once and the codes are auto assigned to all future sections of the course • Section level coding is a great option when there is inconsistency across sections within a course • Section level coding occurs each semester <p>Reports and available queries</p>
