Yields

Data were used from First Census to calculate the yields. Yields are calculated by taking the total amount of FTES and dividing by the total number of related sections. For example, if the total FTES were 24.83 and there were 5 related sections, the resulting yield would be 4.97.

- City/ECC and Miramar College showed improvement in Census Week accounting methods yields in Fall 2012 compared to the previous term (see Table 2). The City College yields for Independent Study Census Week and Independent Study Census Day increased in Fall 2012 compared to Fall 2011. At Mesa College, the Independent Study Census Week yields for Fall 2012 increased compared to Fall 2011. Miramar College showed improvement in Census Day and Work Experience Census Week yields in Fall 2012 compared to Fall 2011.
