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Operational Definitions

Incoming DSPS Students: Any first-time student that was officially enrolled in a class and was classified as having received DSPS services in the year identified. Students concurrently enrolled in a four-year university, degree holders, and high school students are excluded.

Enrollment: The number of seats or duplicated headcount. Drops, never attends, cancelled classes and tutoring classes are excluded.

Persistence: The rate of students who enrolled in a fall term as of official census (eliminating drops and never attends prior to census) and who completed the term with a grade notation of A, B, C, P (Pass), D, F, I, NP (Not Pass), or RD (Report Delayed), and then enrolled as of official census in the subsequent spring term and received a grade notation for that term.

Retention Rate: The percent of students retained in a course out of the total enolled students in that course. The retention rate is calculated by dividing the numerator by the denominator and multiplying by 100. The numerator is the number of students who received any grade notation except W (Withdrawal). The denominator is the total number of valid enrollments as of official census.

Success Rate: The percent of students who successfully completed a course out of the total students enrolled in the course. The success rate is calculated by dividing the numerator by the denominator and multiplying by 100. The numerator is the number of students who received grade notations of A, B, C, or P (Pass). The denominator is the total number of valid enrollments as of official census.

Research Note: The information provided in the All Colleges Basic Skills Report 2011 may be used as a benchmark for the DSPS placement, enrollment, persistence, and outcomes data summarized in this report. The operational definitions, any exclusions made, and the reported basic skills courses and corresponding placement levels match the All Colleges Basic Skills Report 2011.
