

## **San Diego Community College District Non-Credit to Credit Movement**

### **Methodology**

The data used is an unduplicated count of students that attended at least one non-credit course at one of the Continuing Education sites during either the Fall 1997 or Spring 1998 semesters. A total of 78,301 students were enrolled in non-credit classes over these two semesters. Of these students, 5,269 were enrolled in credit courses, prior to their non-credit enrollment or concurrently, during the Fall 1997. These students were removed leaving 73,032 students enrolled in a non-credit class.

This procedure was replicated for students who attended at least one non-credit course Fall 1998 or Spring 1999. Of the 79,871 students, 4,980 students were enrolled in credit courses, prior to their non-credit enrollment or concurrently, during Fall 1998. These students were removed leaving 74,891 students enrolled in a non-credit class either Fall 1998 or Spring 1999.

### **Results**

There were 3,454 students who were enrolled in non-credit classes during Fall 1997 or Spring 1998 and subsequently enrolled in a credit class during Spring 1998, Fall 1998, Spring 1999, Fall 1999 or Spring 2000. Therefore, 4.7% of the 73,032 non-credit students enrolled in Fall 1997 or Spring 1998 later enrolled in a credit class.

There were 2,694 students enrolled in non-credit classes during Fall 1998 or Spring 1999 that eventually enrolled in a credit class during Spring 1999, Fall 1999, Spring 2000 or Fall 2000. Therefore, 4.0% of the 74,891 non-credit students enrolled in Fall 1998 or Spring 1999 subsequently enrolled in a credit class.

The attached tables show the demographics of the students that transferred from non-credit to credit programs.
