



# **DSPS Annual Report**

**Reporting Period: 2013/14**

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# Introduction

## Overview

This report is intended to provide information regarding the course-taking behaviors and outcomes of Disability Support Programs and Services (DSPTS) students. This report includes benchmarks that may be used as a point of reference, including averages for the DSPTS Student population and the All Student population.

## Methodology

The data for this report are generated from the SDCCD Information System. Student demographics, student characteristics, and course-taking patterns are provided separately for each primary term (fall and spring) in 2013/14. Student outcome calculations combine primary terms. FTES is provided for the year (summer, fall, and spring).

Only students enrolled past official census day are measured, and college affiliation is determined by the students' college of coursework to more accurately represent students who take classes at multiple colleges in the district. This report measures online and vocational course enrollments by DSPTS service categories. Note that some students received services in multiple categories. Enrollments for these students are duplicated.

## Operational Definitions

*All Colleges* – Includes City College, Mesa College, Miramar College, and ECC. As some students attend multiple colleges, a count of students or enrollment at each of the colleges and ECC will not sum to an All Colleges total count of students or enrollment.

*DSPTS Special Classes* - Classes with 50% or greater DSPTS-identified student enrollment.

*Enrollments – Credit Colleges*- The number of seats enrolled, or duplicated headcount, as of the class designated census day. Drops, never attends, cancelled, and tutoring classes are excluded, as well as year-long summer in-service classes at Miramar.

*FTES* - Total number of full time equivalent students enrolled. Includes non-residents. Excludes non-state supported, cancelled, and tutoring classes. F-Factor is included when reported annually, but excluded when reported by program.

*Headcount – Continuing Education* - The individual count of students, or unduplicated headcount. Less than one attendance hour, never attends, and cancelled classes are excluded.

*Headcount – Credit Colleges* - The individual count of students, or unduplicated headcount, as of the class designated census day. Drops, never attends, and cancelled classes are excluded, as well as year-long summer in-service classes at Miramar.

*Retention Rate* - The percentage of students who complete a course with a grade of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I or RD out of total official census enrollments. Tutoring and cancelled classes are excluded.

*Success Rate* - The percentage of students who complete a course with a grade of A, B, C, or P out of total official census enrollments. Tutoring, non-credit, and cancelled classes are excluded.
