2000 Transcript Tracking Study Transfers from SDCCD to Private, Independent and Out-of-State Baccalaureate Institutions

Introduction

The Office of Institutional Research (IR) recently concluded a study in which all transcripts mailed from the Student Services transcript office from January 2000-September 2000 were analyzed. The goal of this study was to gather information about where students most commonly transfer to after attending San Diego Community College District (SDCCD). This study focused on transcripts mailed to private and independent four-year colleges and universities.

The 2000 study was a follow-up study to a similar study conducted by the Institutional Research office in 1998. The earlier study had several limitations including limited data on transfers by college. Therefore, the 2000 study was expanded to include a more thorough demographic analysis of the students and the institutions receiving transcripts. The 1998 study was the San Diego Community College's first attempt at tracking transfers to independent and out-of-state institutions. Presently, community college transfer to independent schools data is minimally collected at the state level. However, in order to best meet goal one of the Partnerships for Excellence program initiated in 1995 by the State Chancellor's office, SDCCD proactively began tracking transcripts in 1998 in order to collect this information.

As expected, this transfer project yielded many interesting findings, results and other observations that will be useful in recruiting and retaining future SDCCD students. Additionally, articulation agreements or other partnerships may be established between these institutions. Institutional Research analyzed thousands of records and synthesized the data in the following report. This data is provided in summary and by college.

Methodology

Tracking transcripts from one of the largest community college systems in California and the nation is not an easy task. It required many hours of patience, research, and aggressive follow-up efforts, including conducting telephone calls to more than 300 institutions. This collaborative effort required many different people, including members of the Student Services, Computing Services, and Institutional Research offices to work together to gather this information in an efficient manner. Institutional Research reviewed thousands of transcript requests and successfully received responses from 97% of the transcript receiving institutions.

The study sought to obtain information about private and independent as well as out-of-state institutions. In order to identify these institutions, the following limitations were set to narrow the list of institutions to only those that met the following criteria:

- Not a part of the CSU, UC, or California community college systems.
- Offer bachelor's degrees or higher (but must be at least a baccalaureate granting institution).
- Could include for-profit institutions (such as University of Phoenix)
- Must be accredited.
- Limited to institutions in the United States only.
- Have received at least one transcript from SDCCD between January 2000 and September 30, 2000.
- Not a professional school (for example a massage school) or graduate program.

Once a school was identified as meeting the above criteria, a list of students who sent transcripts to that institution was compiled. This list was then sent to the institution along with follow-up letters asking each institution to verify enrollment for the academic years 1999-2000 or 2000-2001. Surveys were mailed to 509 institutions in order to track 2,514 transcripts between October 2000 and January 2001. Although responses were slow at first, through an aggressive follow-up plan, Institutional Research received responses from 97% of the institutions surveyed.

Findings and Observations

Institutional Research analyzed 2,514 transcripts that met the above-mentioned criteria. Based on confirmed enrollments, these transcripts yielded 1,774 transfers, or a transfer rate of 70.6%. It is important to note that this is a duplicated count of transfers. In other words, if a student sent transcripts to the University of Arizona and Arizona State University and enrolled at Arizona State, this student would be counted as transferring once but sending 2 transcripts. This may account for a lower transfer rate.

Institutional Research has provided demographic analysis of 1,396 of the 1,774 transfer students. Three hundred and seventy eight students are excluded from this analysis because they last attended SDCCD prior to 1991 and therefore limited demographic data is available. An examination of the students shows a breakdown by college:

The gender of the transfer students was nearly evenly split, with women transferring at a slightly higher rate (55%) vs. male students (45%). The ethnic breakdown of the transfers shows some disproportionate transfer rates when compared to the Fall 2000 SDCCD student profile. White students transfer at a higher rate than the percentage of white students in the general population while Latino students transfer at a lower rate than the percentage of students in the general population.

Not surprisingly, the greatest number of transfers was to local institutions, with National University overwhelmingly receiving the greatest number of transfers (605). An analysis of National University is attached in attachment D. Other top transfer institutions include the University of San Diego (122), Chapman (39), Point Loma Nazarene (31) and Southern Illinois University at Coronado (27). The geographic location of transfers ranged from the University of Alaska to the University of Maine with a large number of students transferring to institutions near military bases. For example, University of Maryland's military program, as well as Southern Illinois University and Embry Riddle's multi-campus program received over ninety transcripts from SDCCD. Perhaps this can be attributed to their proximities to or on military bases or the availability of on-line distance education programs.

Students also transferred to many highly regarded and ranked institutions including Pepperdine University, University of Southern California, University of North Carolina, and the Art Center of Design in Pasadena. Unfortunately, despite numerous attempts to obtain transfer data, Stanford University did not participate in this study for reasons unknown. Eighteen transcripts were sent to Stanford during this period.

Slightly more than one third of students (34%) last attended SDCCD at some point during the past two academic years, (1999-00 and 2000-01) prior to transferring. However, 378 transfer students (21%) had not attended SDCCD since prior to 1991, with some students last attending in the late 1970s. These students were excluded from the analysis due to data limitations.

The average number of cumulative units was 29.82 and the average GPA was 2.85:

Conclusions/Recommendations

In conclusion, the findings in this study show students transfer to a wide range of geographic locations as well as diverse types of higher education institutions after attending SDCCD. This information is helpful in understanding the types of students who most commonly transfer. Additionally, this information will be used to meet Partnerships for Excellence goals. For example, more students transferred to National University (605) than to the entire University of California system in 1998-1999 (349). Therefore, limiting Partnerships for Excellence transfer data to the CSU and UC systems only does not allow for a complete transfer picture.

Institutional Research observed that the California Post-Secondary Education Commission (CPEC) is limited in the transfer data they collect from private institutions in California. Additionally, data that is available is incomplete and therefore unreliable. For example, CPEC's data shows zero transfers from SDCCD over several years in the 1990s to National University. Through this research study, it is clear that this information is incorrect. Therefore, Institutional Research will work with CPEC to make certain that reliable data is available.

Finally, Institutional Research recommends that this information be used to establish transfer programs to local private institutions as well as for public relations purposes in recruiting future SDCCD students. National University and the University of Phoenix have recently entered into data sharing agreements with the Institutional Research so transfer data will be more readily available and more easily analyzed.












Transfers by Ethnicity
