Highlight of the Findings

HIGHLIGHT OF THE FINDINGS

District

1. Overall, the number of awards conferred for the District increased by 5%, from 6,797 in 2011/12 to 7,166 in 2012/13.

All Colleges

- 1. Overall, the number of awards conferred (degrees and certificates) decreased 6% from last year, with 3,362 awards conferred in 2012/13, down from 3,567 in 2011/12. The number of awards conferred in 2011/12 is the highest it has been in over five years.
- 2. Among awards conferred from 2008/09 to 2012/13, on average, AA/AS degrees were conferred nearly two times more (65%) than all other certificates combined (35%). However, when considering only certificates, certificates requiring 29 or fewer units (47%) were conferred less often than certificates requiring 30 to 59 units (52%). Certificates requiring 60 or more units were the least conferred (1%).
- 3. In 2012/13, AA/AS degrees accounted for approximately 65% of the awards conferred at City College, 75% of the awards conferred at Mesa College, and 56% of the awards conferred at Miramar College.

4. Between 2008/09 and 2012/13, the top 5 awards conferred (degrees and certificates) were as follows (excluding transfer studies and liberal arts): Business Administration (n = 1,053), Biology-Allied Health (n = 560), Social/Behavioral Sciences (n = 550), Fire Technology (n = 527), and Language Arts and Humanities (n = 442).

- 5. The top five AA/AS degrees conferred between 2008/09 and 2012/13 were as follows (excluding transfer studies and liberal arts): Biology-Allied Health (n = 560), Social/Behavioral Sciences (n = 550), Business Administration (n = 518), Language Arts and Humanities (n = 442), and Psychology (n = 347).
- 6. In 2012/13 there were a total of 348 AA/AS degrees conferred in STEM majors. This represents 16% of the total AA/AS degrees conferred in 2012/13.
- 7. Between 2008/09 and 2012/13, the Radiologic Technology certificate was the top certificate conferred requiring 60 or more units (n = 33).
- 8. For certificates requiring 30 to 59 units, the top certificates conferred between 2008/09 and 2012/13 were as follows: Business Administration (n = 531), Behavioral Sciences-Alcohol & Other Drug Studies (n = 242), Cosmetology (n = 164), Fire Technology (n = 136), and Paralegal (n = 127).
- 9. The top five certificates conferred between 2008/09 and 2012/13 requiring 29 or fewer units were as follows: Child Development Teacher (n = 284), Child Development Associate Teacher (n = 257), Fire Technology (n = 160), Electricity (n = 144), and Accounting (n = 138).

Continuing Education

- 1. Overall, the number of awards conferred (certificates, GEDs, and high school diplomas) at Continuing Education increased by 18% from last year, with 3,804 awards conferred in 2012/13, up from 3,230 in 2011/12.
- 2. Between 2008/09 and 2012/13, Certificates of Completion represented the majority of awards conferred at Continuing Education (84%), followed by high school diplomas (9%) and GED certificates (7%).

- 3. The number of Certificates of Completion conferred increased by 19% since last year, with 3,606 conferred in 2012/13, up from 3,028 in 2011/12.
- 4. The number of GED certificates conferred decreased by 28% since last year, with 79 conferred in 2012/13, down from 109 in 2011/12.
- 5. The number of high school diplomas increased by 28% since last year, with 119 conferred in 2012/13, up from 93 in 2011/12.
- 6. The top five programs that awarded Certificates of Completion between 2008/09 and 2012/13 were as follows: Nursing Assistant Training (n = 662), Sewing Fundamentals (n = 305), Air Conditioning/Heating I (n = 261), Culinary Arts I (n = 246), ESL Beginning Program (n = 244).






City College Percentage Distribution of Awards by Year




Mesa College Percentage Distribution of Awards by Year
