RISING TO SUCCESS PATHWAYS

Rising to Success (R2S) Pathways, a learning community program, creates educational communities that provide intensive support and services guiding students age 25+* on a pathway to completion, career, and/or transition to college.

R2S PATHWAYS focuses on the student's journey and breaking down barriers to completion by empowering students. The program creates possibilities for achieving self-sufficiency and showing students how to succeed with education and career goals.





R2S PATHWAYS PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- » Must be age 25+*
- » Schedule a program eligibility appointment (must meet program eligibility requirements)
- » Complete required intake processes
- » Attend an R2S PATHWAYS program orientation
- » Complete an SDCE career training program orientation (as applicable) and work with a counselor to develop an education plan to enroll in a career training pathway
- » Complete SDCE's College and Career Readiness course
- » Commit to actively participate in your success

PARTICIPANTS ARE COLLEGE & CAREER READY

- Earn a job training certificate in as little as six (6) months
- » Receive textbooks, school supplies, program and class materials
- » Gain assistance with basic needs and additional education costs (e.g. childcare, food, testing fees, software)
- » Receive transportation assistance for approved program activities
- Explore career opportunities in paid apprenticeship and internship opportunities
- » Access career services to help with job search and placement
- » Attend workshops and professional learning opportunities
- » Access a computer lab
- » Successfully transition to college or career



R2S PATHWAYS AFFILIATE STUDENTS

- » Must be age 25+*
- » Apply for success grants
- » Provide direct support services
- » Access computer lab
- » Attend workshops and presentations
- » Provide resources and referrals to internal and external programs and services
- » Provide a lending library
