Are you interested in pursuing a Science, Technology, Engineering or Math (STEM) degree, but think you're not ready or don't know where to start?

STEM Core is a one-year math-focused prep program that prepares students for a major in the sciences. Students participate in a set of courses that prepare them for higher-level study, and receive additional support from STEM counseling, career advising, and tutoring. Following completion of the program, STEM Core students may also have the opportunity to participate in paid summer internships.

Hispanic, low-income, and/or first generation college students are encouraged to apply. If accepted, participants will be required to attend a mandatory summer orientation.
