#### **Enrollment Outlook**

- In summer 2010 as of opening day, headcount was down 10%, FTES was down 8% with a 11% decline in sections.
- As of opening day in fall 2010, headcount for the colleges was 8% higher than the same time last year and FTES was up 7% compared to fall 2009.
- ▶ Based upon the current enrollment, the district is projected to be approximately 4.4% over the funded cap (1,834 FTES) for 2010/11.
