CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY COLLEGE GUIDED PATHWAYS

Background

- Adapted from the American Association of Community Colleges (AACC) Pathways model
- \$150M earmarked in Governor's 2017-2018 budget
- 5 – year effort specified in legislation



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Guided Pathways Framework

- Comprehensive approach to improving student completion
- Overarching framework to integrate existing initiatives
 - Student Success (SSSP)
 - Student Equity
 - Basic Skills Transformation
 - College Promise
 - Strong Workforce
- Goal is to provide students with clear *program maps* to completion, transfer and employment.
 - Course sequences
 - Program milestones
 - Learning outcomes



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Readiness Assessment

- At the core of participation in the program
- Demonstrates college's capacity and commitment to:
 - Support the process
 - Implement institutional change
 - Broadly engage faculty
 - Use data and technology to track student progress and outcomes
 - Develop partnerships



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Program Participation Status

- City College, Mesa College, Miramar College will have completed the required elements to file an application to participate by the deadline December 23 (formerly November 15).
- Comprehensive multi-year work plans are being developed at each college involving a broad group of faculty and staff.
- Multi-year work plans are due to the Chancellor's office by March 30, 2018.



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
