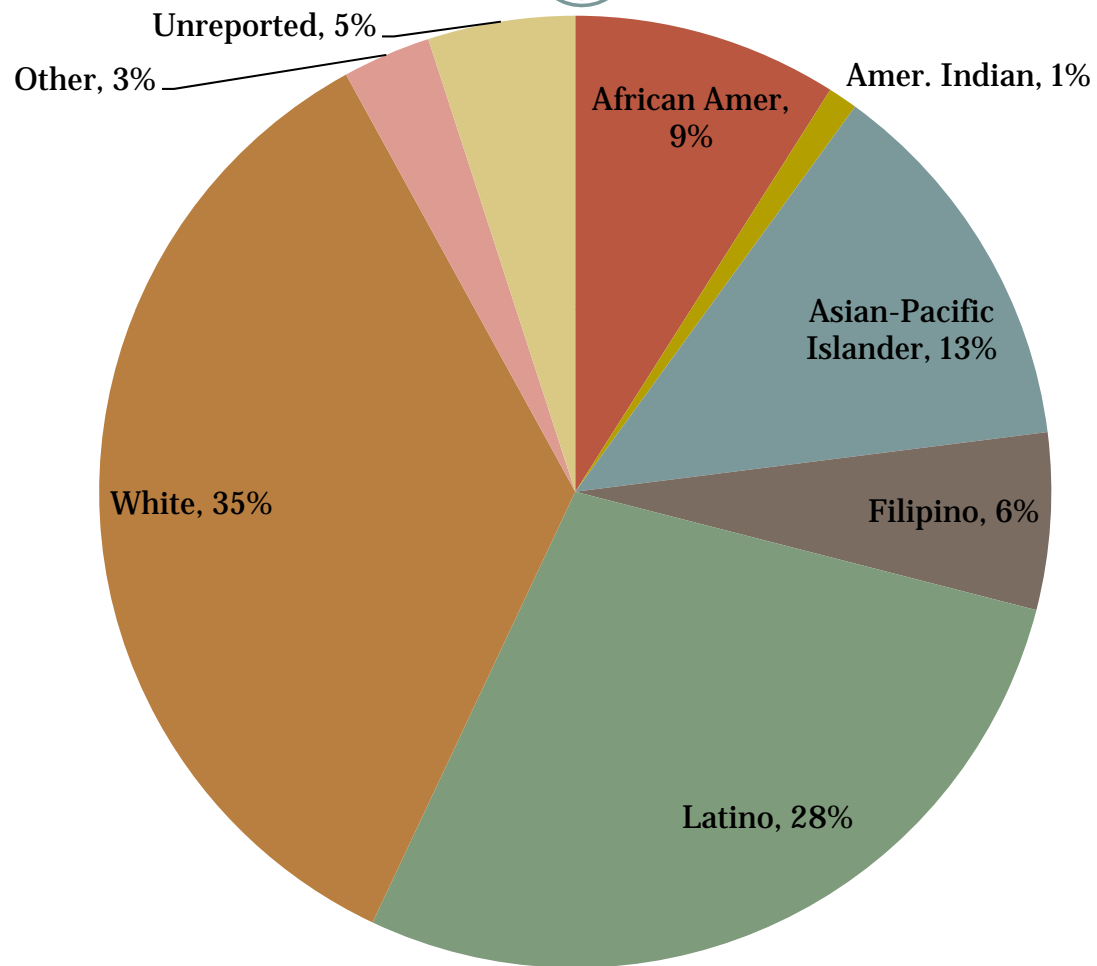

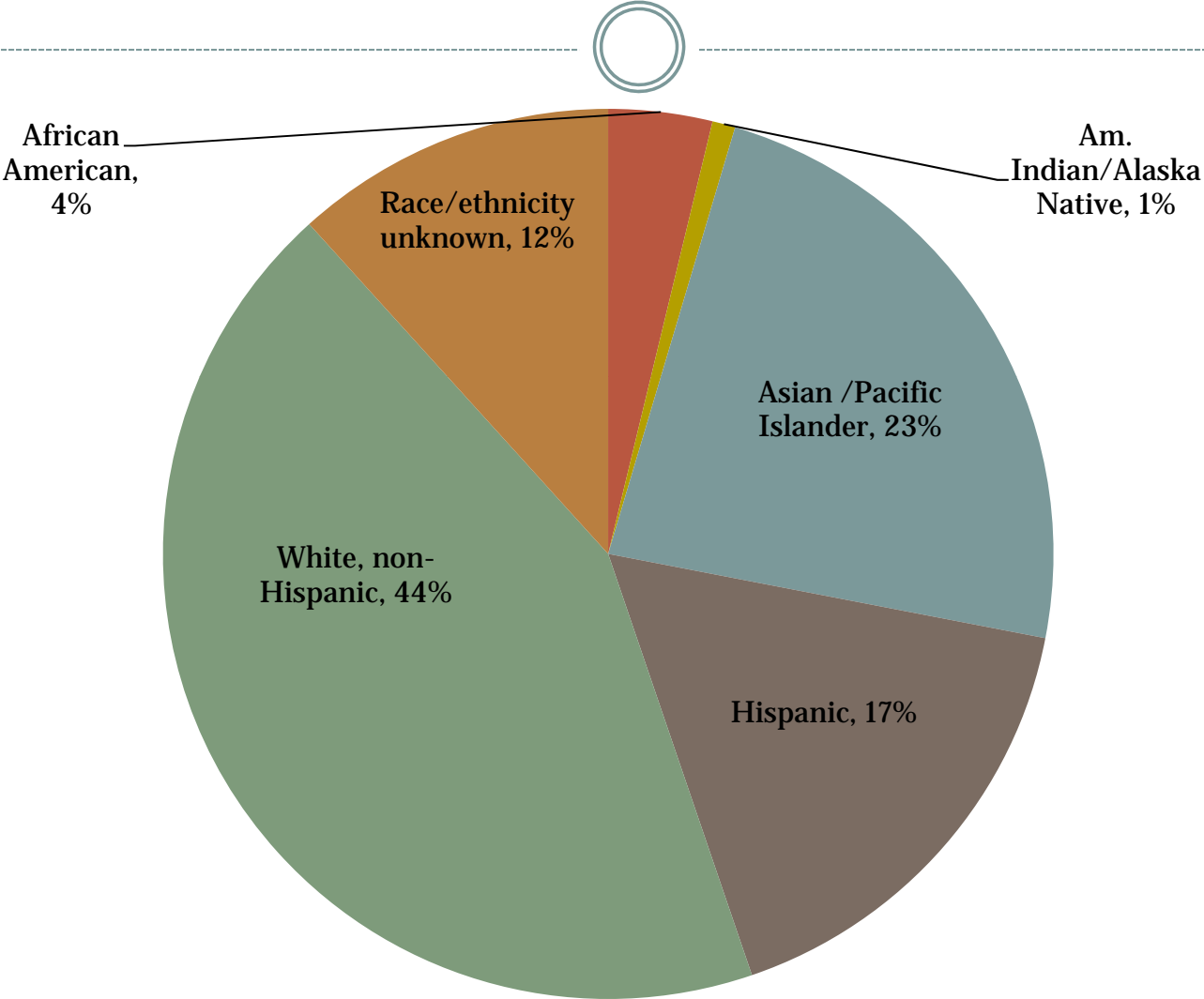

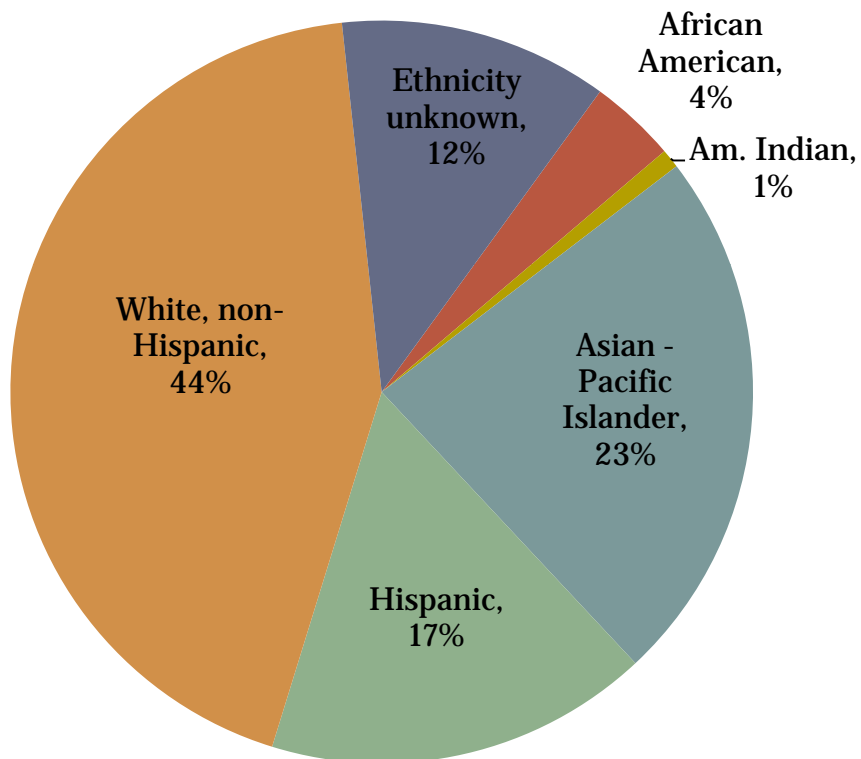

GRS Completion Rates by Ethnicity

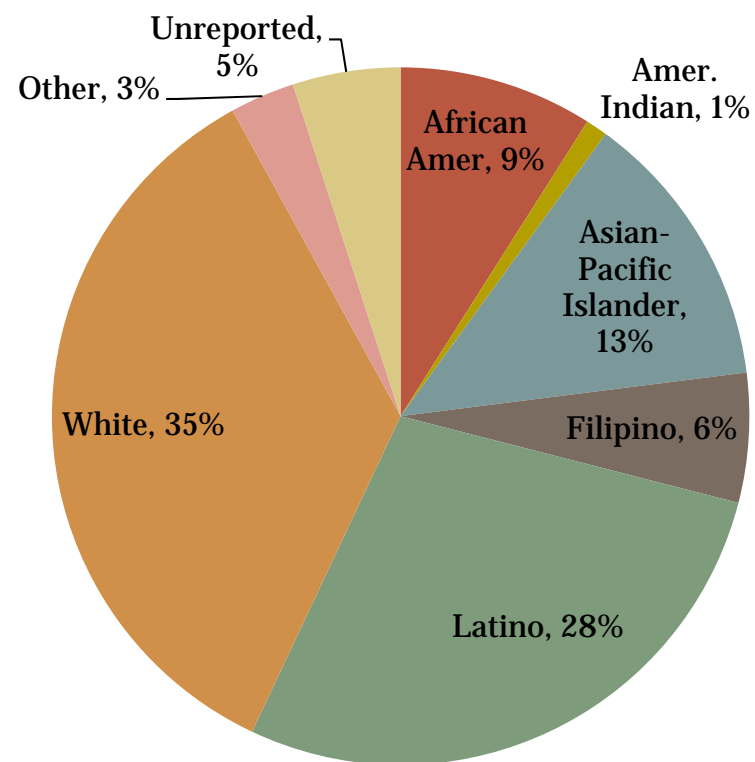


GRS & Fall '08 Student Comparison

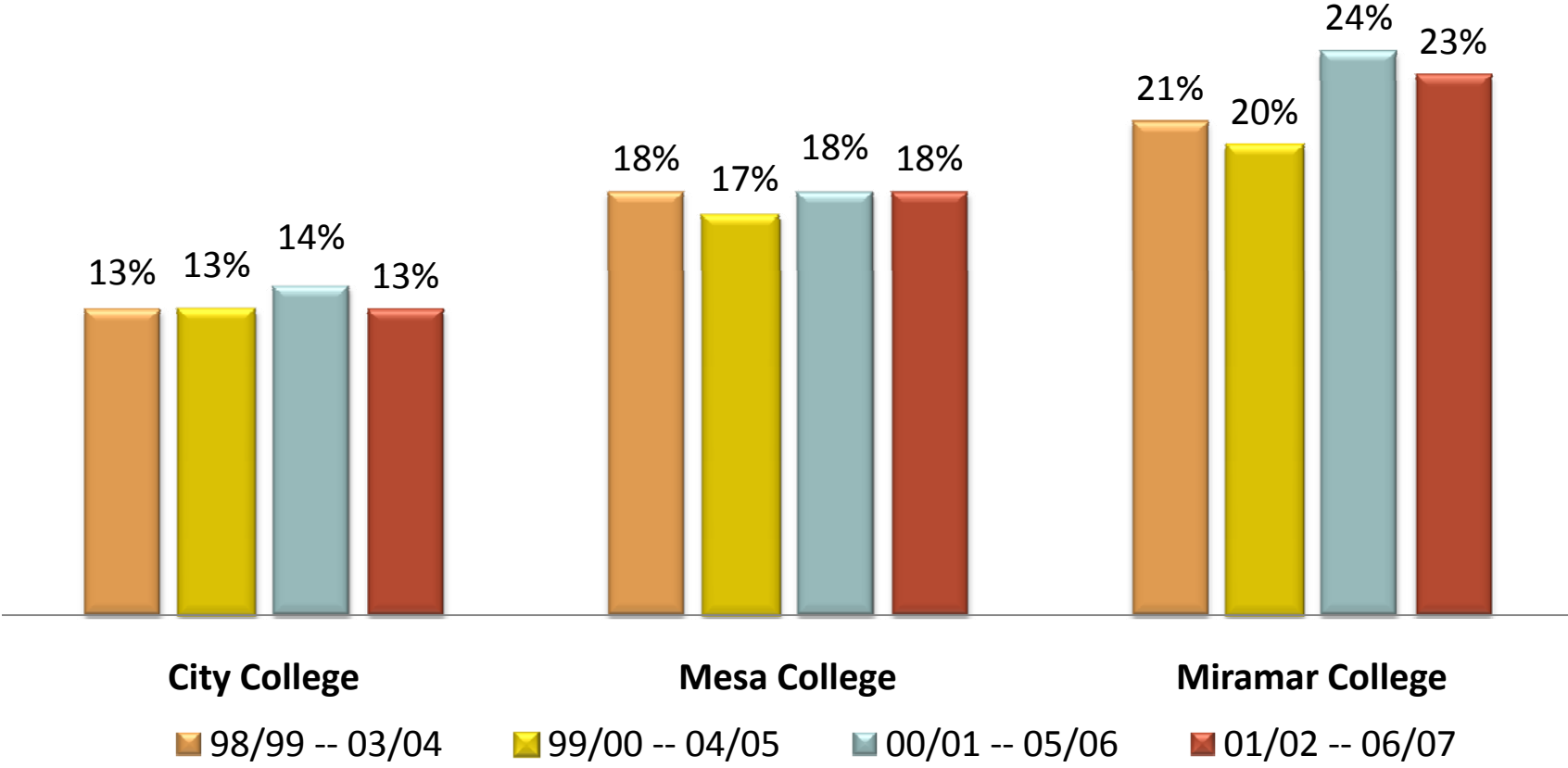
STUDENT PROGRESS & ACHIEVEMENT RATES

SPAR 2008



- A cohort of first-time students with a minimum of 12 units earned who attempted a degree, certificate, or transfer threshold course within six years and who are shown to have achieved any of the following five outcomes:
 1. **Earned an AA/AS**
 2. Earned a Certificate (18 or more units)
 3. Transferred to a 4-year institution
 4. Achieved “Transfer Directed” status (successful completion of both transfer- level Math and English courses)
 5. Achieved “Transfer Prepared” status (successful completion of 60 UC /CSU transferable units with a GPA ≥ 2.0)

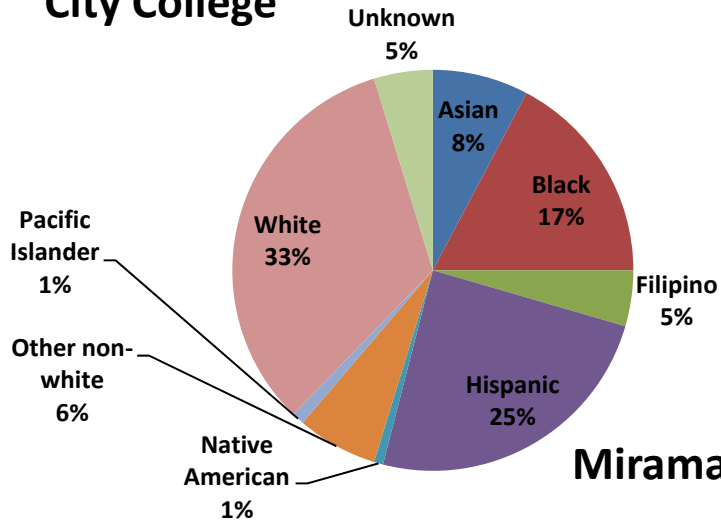
SPAR Cohort with Earned AA/AS



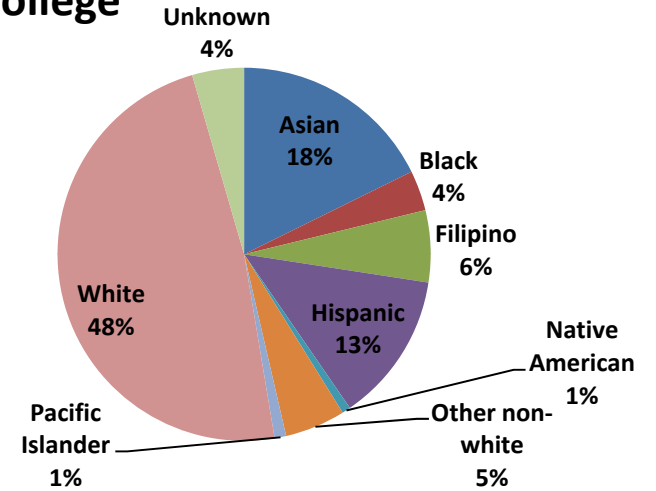
SPAR Cohort w/ Earned Degree by Ethnicity



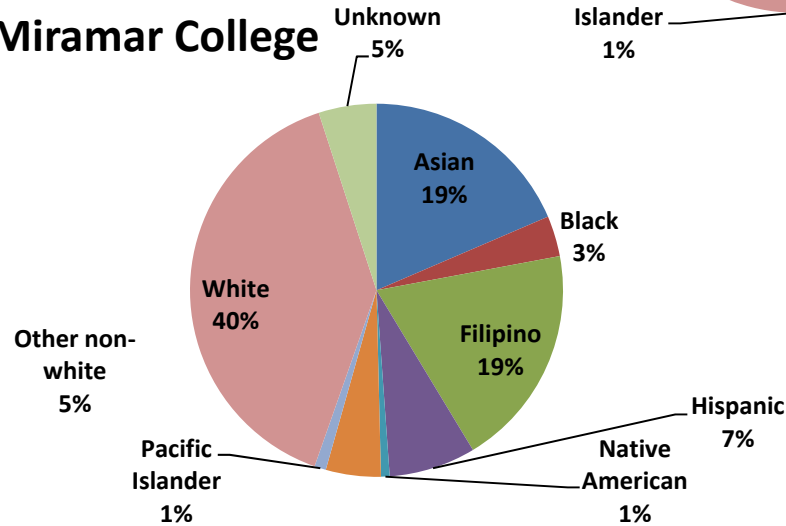

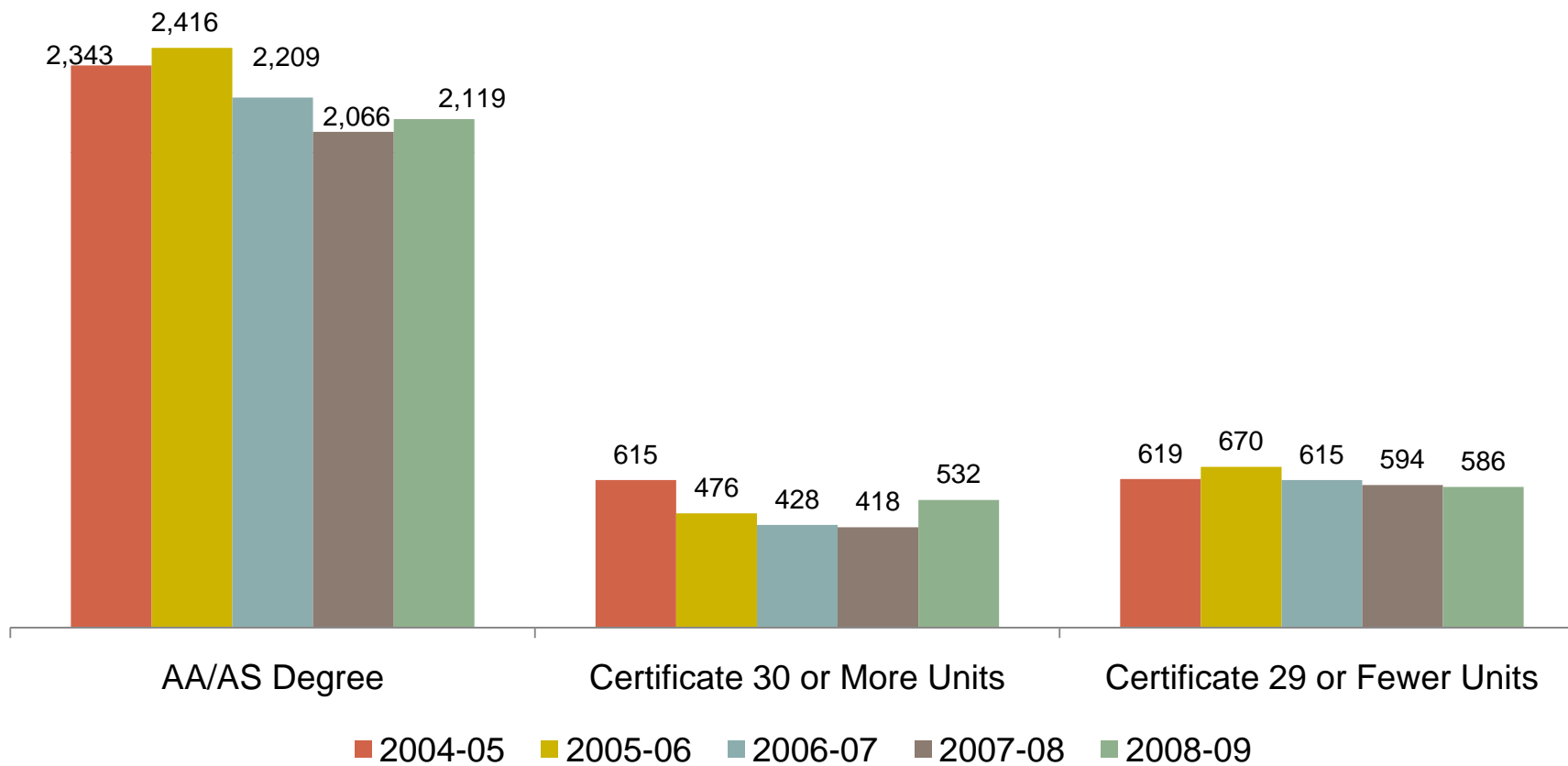
