






Transfer Volume 2008/09 – 2012/13



Transfer Volume by Demographics

- Overall, there was a 7% increase in transfer volume between 2008/09 and 2012/13. Most ethnic groups showed increases in transfer volume:
 - African American: 17% increase
 - American Indian: -43% decrease
 - Asian/Pacific Islander: 10% increase
 - Filipino: 2% increase
 - Latino 46% increase
 - White: 1% increase
- Females showed a 2% decrease, and males 18% increase.


Top Transfer Destinations



Transfer Destination Trends

- Overall, the annual transfer volume for all colleges in the district increased by 7% between 2008-09 to 2012-13 with a slight uptick between 2011/12 and 2012/13 (3,396 to 3,434).
- The top two transfer destinations districtwide and at each college continue to be San Diego State University, and University of California San Diego.
- National was the top third most popular for City and Mesa students, and CSU San Marcos for Miramar students.
- Overall transfer volume to UCSD, University of Phoenix, and CSU San Marcos decreased (25%, 7%, 53%, respectively) between 2008-09 and 2012-13, while transfer volume to SDSU and National University increased 40% and 91%, respectively, within the same time period.
- SDSU continues to be the top transfer destination across all ethnic groups. The second top destination being UCSD, with the exception of African American students whose second top destination is University of Phoenix.


Transfer Rates
