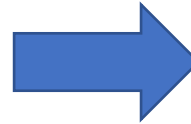
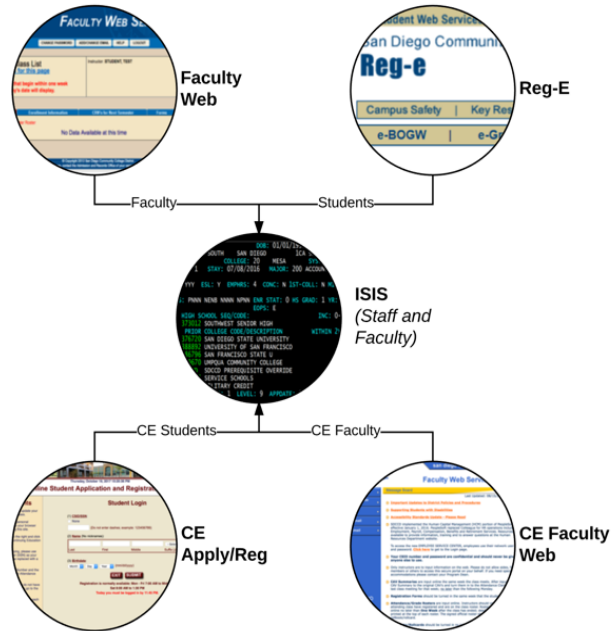

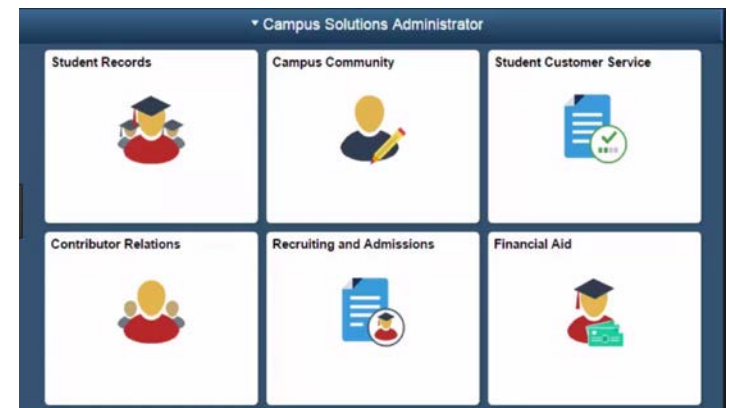
CAMPUS SOLUTIONS BACKGROUND

- Third pillar in the PeopleSoft Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) Software
- Implementation for Campus Solutions began in 2014
- Implementation grew from a districtwide team of 15 to more than 100
 - Staff and faculty from City, Mesa, and Miramar Colleges, Continuing Education, and the District Office
- System consists of seven modules
 - Campus Community, Admissions, Student Records, Academic Advising, Curriculum Management, Financial Aid and Student Financials
- Financial Aid module went live April 2018, for the Fall 2018 financial aid cycle
- Multiple phase launches for transition to Summer 2019 semester
 - Curriculum module went live in February 2019

JUNE GO LIVE

- **June 24**
Restrict access for changes to legacy systems
- **June 30**
Final conversion to Campus Solutions of Spring grades, academic standing and transcript information (college)

SEPTEMBER GO LIVE

- **September 30**
 - Close the 2018-2019 Financial Aid Year
 - Transfer end of year Student Financials Balances to Campus Solutions

DEC/JAN 2020 GO LIVE

- **End of Year**
 - Academic Standing Calculations
 - 320/321 Apportionment reporting
 - State MIS Reporting
 - 1098-T Tax Reporting

STUDENT AND EMPLOYEE SUPPORT TRAINING

- 94 training sessions are planned through August 2019
- Road shows scheduled on campus for students:
 - April 9 to April 11 – Online Class Schedule
 - May 6 to June 7 – Summer 2019 registration support
 - July 9 to August 30 – Fall 2019 registration support
- User training manuals created
- Post Go Live triage as well as individual and small group training beginning May

Student Support Team

- Online help system available where users can submit questions
- Outreach offices will serve as additional support for students on campus
- 10 Campus Solutions Business Analysts and key leads (15 employees) will staff a “support desk” for faculty and students from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. beginning April 22
