SB1440 - CSU TRANSFER DEGREE OVERVIEW

- ⊙ Effective January 1, 2011
- ⊙ Intended to streamline transfer and increase access
- ⊙ Guarantees admission to a CSU for any student that completes an associate degree specially designed for transfer to CSU
- ⊙ Specifies that a community college or CSU cannot add any additional requirements for the associate degree than what is required for transfer
- ⊙ CSU cannot require more than 60 units at CSU after transfer
