Probation is determined in two ways, one is based on progress and the other is based on grade point average (GPA) as defined below:

- **Progress** is determined by the number of "W," "I," or "NP" grades. You must complete at least 61% of units attempted to maintain good standing.
- Grade Point Average -You must maintain a minimum 2.0 grade point average at all times.

If you disqualify by not meeting progress or GPA standards, you will lose your registration priority and your eligibility for the Board of Governor's fee Waiver (BOGW).
