


Summary on African American Transfer Students July 27, 2020

Transfer Volume

African American students comprise about 6% of all transfers. In 2018/19, 270 African American students transferred from an SDCCD institution, a 17% increase since 2014/15 (230 in 2014/14 vs. 270 in 2018/19). In the last five years, a total of 1,173 African American students transferred from the District out of a total of 19,956 total transfers.

Number of Transfers by Academic Year



While there has been an increase in the number of African American students transferring from the District, this increase is smaller compared to Latinx (59%), Filipino (50%), and Asian/Pacific Islander students (48%) as shown in the table below.

Three of the top five transfer destinations for African American students are public institutions. San Diego State University has consistently been the top transfer institution for African American students within the District.
