San Diego Foundation Grant

Below is a breakdown of how City, Mesa and Miramar colleges and Continuing Education will share the SD Foundation Grant in the amount of \$70,000.

The District's total number of students is **11,684** or **75%** of the students residing in District 4 Zip code. The other SD County districts served the remaining **3,907** students or **25%** of the total students.
