







## Osher Initiative for California Community College Students Scholarship Application

Thanks to the generosity of The Bernard Osher Foundation, thousands of California Community College students, like you, may receive an Osher Scholarship as part of the California Community Colleges Scholarship Endowment. Mr. Osher's vision is to invest in community college students to "not only benefit the community college students of today but countless more for years to come."

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- Student attending fall 2016 and spring 2017 semesters must have completed 24 or more "degree applicable" semester units (or the equivalent) at the time of the initial scholarship disbursement.
- Student must have a 2016-2017 FAFSA on file with the college.
- Student must be enrolled at least half-time (6 or more units) during all terms in which the award remains active.
- Student must be enrolled at the college where the financial aid will be received.
- Student must have received a CCC Board of Governor's Fee Waiver.
- Awards will be adjusted based on enrolled status and determined as follows:
  - Full-time (12 or more units per term) = up to \$550/semester
  - Three-quarter-time (9 11.99 units per term) = up to \$412.5/semester
  - Half-time (6 8.99 units per term) = up to \$275/semester

**Amount of award:** Annual Awards up to \$1,100 (will be pro-rated based on enrollment) **Selection Criteria:** First-come, first-served, based on the eligibility criteria above, as well as

questions 1 – 6 on the scholarship application
