Dear Students,

As you all know, the success of our pandemic response has depended on a number of different approaches for combating COVID-19—social distancing, enhanced cleaning, controlled facilities access, restrictions on visitors, and events.

As of June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021, San Diego Community College District (SDCCD) will require all new and returning students to present proof of COVID-19 vaccination if attending any in-person activity (including in-person exams) or class for the Fall 2021 semester. Looking ahead, we know that widespread vaccination will facilitate a return to in-person instruction and activities.

Vaccination is not required for students enrolled exclusively in online courses and/or those who do not come on campus; however, SDCCD strongly encourages all members of the district community to be vaccinated. We believe adding COVID-19 vaccination requirements will help accelerate the number of available in-person course offerings and on-campus activities.
