1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of May 18, 2011, were approved with the following <u>revisions</u> (as requested by Robin Watkins):

STUDENT PARKING PERMIT FEE INCREASE REVISITED

Robin Watkins, Classified Senate President of Mesa College, suggested cutting summer and daily rates if fees are raised; she expressed her opposition to the fee increase. Another suggestion was to have faculty and staff pay for parking permits (this would be a bargaining issue). Franchesca Gade, Associated Student President for Miramar College, speaking for the student body of all three colleges, voiced opposition to the increased parking fees.

2. REVIEW OF BOARD AGENDA FOR JULY 7, 2011

The agenda for the July 7, 2011, Board Meeting was opened for review by Chancellor Carroll. Each item was discussed and satisfied.

3. STATE BUDGET & PLANNING

Chancellor Carroll reported that the state budget was finalized and that the SDCCD budget planning was in line with the state plan. Unfortunately, she noted, the state budget is based on revenue estimates that may not be realized and which may trigger a mid-year increase in the student enrollment fee by another \$10 per unit, as well as other reductions in state enrollment support.

4. **AB 515 UPDATE**

Chancellor Carroll announced that AB 515, (increased fee rate authorization for credit classes) has been removed from active consideration.
