# 1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

# 2. REVIEW OF BOARD AGENDA

The agenda for the August 28, 2014, Board Meeting was opened for review by Chancellor Carroll. Each item was discussed and satisfied.

#### 3. STATE BUDGET UPDATE

Executive Vice Chancellor Bonnie Dowd updated the council on the state budget concerning SSSP funds match requirements. The Board of Governors (BOG) changed the regulations allowing the State Chancellor to set the rate of General Fund match required from 3:1 to 2:1 for SSSP funds received in 2014-15. The regulations have also been changed to expand the types of expenditures that may be used to meet match requirements. Dr. Dowd said that these changes are a big help to all districts because with the emphasis on student success funding in the state budget and various accountability requirements, it is likely that more funds will be provided in future budget years making it more difficult for districts to meet the General Fund match requirements. She also reported that there are no new Noncredit SSSP funds being provided beyond the original matriculation funds, which are now identified as SSSP funds under the Student Success Act of 2012, in the 2014-15 budget year.

Vice Chancellor of Student Services Lynn Neault handed out copies of the updated districtwide evaluations model summary and explained the background, accomplishments and recommendations from the survey as well as ongoing improvements.
