Safety Tips

- 1. PROGRAM COLLEGE POLICE DISPATCH NUMBERS INTO YOUR PHONE Within the campus community our police department can respond to emergencies much faster than other local law enforcement. You may call us at 619-388-6405 or from any campus phone or callbox.
- REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY Criminals do not want to be seen or heard. For that reason they rarely commit crime in front of police officers. We rely on the community to report suspicious activity. We would much rather respond and not be needed than to not be called when something could have been prevented. Trust your instincts; if something does not feel right, it probably isn't.
- 3. BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS Avoid going to secluded areas of the campus alone. If public restrooms are in a dark or concealed area of the campus, find a trusted classmate or colleague to go to these areas with you. We also encourage everyone to take advantage of our safety escort program, which provides a walking escort to and from your vehicle by one of our uniformed officers.
