

# First (Freshman) Year Experience Program

# Business Process Fall 2012

## First Semester:

- Pre-Program Requirements:
  - o Completes orientation and counseling;
  - o Takes English and Math assessment test; and
  - Attends a Registration Workshop.
- Develops an Education Plan.
- College prepares a list of eligible FYE students and sends list to District Student Services for priority registration assignment.
- FYE students register for classes in Reg-e on day and time, as specified in their Education Plan per the college.
  - o *City:* Group registration setting under guidance of FYE counselors.
  - *Mesa:* Students to register on their own.
    - Within two days of registration, counselors verify student is enrolled in agreed upon classes as stated on their FYE contract:
      - If not enrolled in accordance with FYE contract, student is notified and is given one week to make the corrections to their schedule or they will be dropped from classes and program.
      - Students may drop classes on their own in Reg-e, at any time.
  - o *Miramar:* Students registered manually through Admissions.
- Produce report of all FYE student enrollments for each college (alpha by college for verification).
- > FYE hold will be put on the student record systematically by the district.
- For the first semester, all classes must be taken at the college where the student is participating in FYE.
- Counselors to verify enrollment status within 2 weeks of registration and drop students from the program who are not following their education plan.

#### Second Semester:

- Student is dropped if he/she did not meet first semester obligations as specified on the contract.
- > Same registration process as first semester.
- Students to receive one day enrollment priority advantage in continuing student group (2<sup>nd</sup> day of registration).

### **Continuing Education FYE:**

- Continuing Education counselors to identify students who will participate in the Continuing Education FYE (ACE<sup>2</sup>) program and provide a list of the participants to the college.
- Continuing Education counselors will work with incoming Continuing Education FYE cohort to ensure contracts are signed and students follow up with the FYE counselor at the college prior to fall registration so that they can be referred to DSPS/EOPS, as needed.
- Once all components of program are completed, contract requirements and registration process is same as for regular FYE program.

## **City College**

#### Please initial:

- The first appointment which is a group session, must be completed before the end of the 6<sup>th</sup> week of the semester. A minimum of 2 counseling sessions are required per session. If I need to cancel or reschedule, a 24 hour notice is required.
- Attend tutorial sessions as planned by my FYE counselor or FYE Peer Mentor with City College English Tutoring Center, Mathematics Center, or group SI (remember, tutorial sessions are important aspects of academic success).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Meet with my FYE Counselor to create an individualized Education Plan by the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (EOPS students must complete an Education Plan by the 10<sup>th</sup> week of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Attend at least 2 FYE sponsored campus events/activities/field trips (2 events required per semester).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Attend at least 2 FYE Student Success Workshops both Fall and Spring semesters.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Meet monthly with FYE Peer Mentors; including a Self Report on academic progress.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Meet with a counselor prior to withdrawing from FYE to complete the Exit Form.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that NOT adhering to the terms above means, I will lose the following:
  - Lose "early registration" status for enrollment.
    - Receive my original registration date and will be administratively dropped from all classes.
