- 1.0 Approval of Minutes
 - November 7, 2013
 - Approved
- 2.0 Disgualification Letter to Students Revisited
 - The Council revisited the disqualification letter/notice that goes out to students that were disqualified three or more times.
 - The Council reviewed the notice and made minor changes.
 - The Council requested data for this group of students. Gail Conrad will report back at a future meeting with the data.
 - It was agreed to revisit the disqualification process and student email notifications next spring. The focus will be on the logistics of the current process and if there are any enhancements that can be made.
- 3.0 Spring 2014 Welcome Letter (Draft)
 - The Council was provided with a draft of the spring 2014 *Welcome Letter* that will be mailed to students on January 13, 2014.
 - The Council reviewed and made minor edits to the letter.

 - The final report will be presented at Chancellor's Cabinet on December 17, 2013.
- 5.0 Proposed Student Services Council Meeting Schedule
 - The Council discussed and approved the Student Services Council meeting schedule for spring 2014.
- 6.0 Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) Update
 - The Council was provided with an update of the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) vendor software selections. The ERP Committee will be discussing the pros and cons of the two software vendors.
 - The Council was asked to consult with their constituents on their thoughts and/or suggestions on the two software vendors.

- 9.0 UCSD University Link Program
 - The Vice Presidents of Student Services were reminded to provide their plan to promote the University of California San Diego (UCSD) *University Link Program*, which guarantees admission to UCSD.
 - The Council discussed the program requirements as follows:
 - o Family income is no more than \$40,000 per year:
 - Cumulative 3.5 Grade Point Average (GPA) by the end of fall term;
 - o Must enroll first semester at a local partner community college; and
 - Must transfer to UCSD in three years.

- Gail Conrad will present their feedback to Chancellor's Cabinet on December 17, 2013.
